How to get to the Language Laboratory:

From the **MSE Library side** (east door) of the building. Take the stairway or the elevator to the 5th floor.

From the Ames Hall side (west door), **walk through the hallway to the other side** and take the elevator or stairway to the 5th floor.

Access for handicapped

From the lower quad, enter the east door of the passageway between Krieger and Maryland Halls.

Turn right through the double doors.

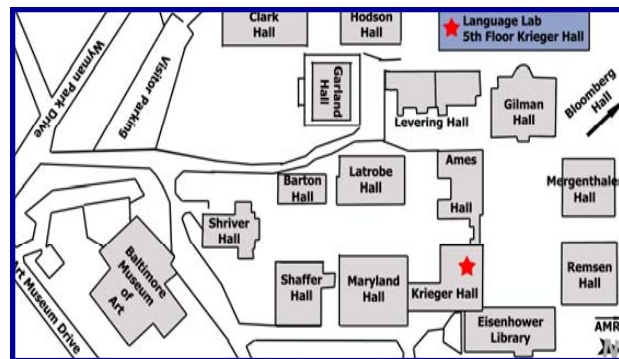
Follow the hallway through another doorway until you arrive at the elevator on your left. Take the elevator to the 5th floor.

From the upper quad, enter the building using the access ramp at the north end of the building (near the MSE Library).

Turn right down the hallway and proceed to the elevator, which will be to the left.

Welcome to the Language Laboratory at Johns Hopkins University. Located on the fifth floor of Krieger Hall, the lab provides in-lab and remote facilities for the use of multimedia materials and assists all foreign language departments in the selection and development of technology-based courseware for their programs. The facility supports individual learning at computerized workstations, as well as classroom instruction via a media distribution system. Satellite news broadcasts, recordings, and high-speed duplication are some of the services offered to students, faculty, and staff of the University. The laboratory has been equipped with current technology used for language acquisition.

Student Services

During the first week of your class, you should go to the Language Laboratory in Krieger Hall, 5th floor. Present your J-card to the desk attendant, who will register you into our system and collect your lab service fee. You may pay the \$7 fee using cash, check, or J-Cash.

This entitles you to use all the lab's services and materials relating to your

course, including the audiotape checkout service and access to the online audio files.

Material will be made available in accordance with your instructor's schedule.

You may also print one copy of your language homework on the lab's laser printer at no additional charge.

The lab fee will be refunded if you drop the course within the first two weeks of classes.

For your information...

The audio materials used in the checkout service have been prepared under special contract with the University.

Because of copyright regulations, you may only have one cassette or CD out at a time for home practice.

The Language Lab will replace damaged material only if you return the damaged item to us for replacement at no charge.

If you lose your tape or CD we will issue you a new one for a charge of \$2 per tape or CD. If you lose more than one, we will charge you the full lab fee.

Foreign Language Faculty Services
