### Course Description:

Russian 208 is a multimedia course in the language, literature, and culture of the Russian-speaking world, including opportunities in business, international relations, and social work. This program emphasizes *communicative competence* in four areas: reading, writing, speaking, and listening. No previous study of Russian is assumed.

From the very first day of class, you will be hearing authentic, spontaneous Russian spoken at normal speed. You are encouraged to participate and to pay close attention to gestures and other visual clues in order to surmise what is being said. This strategy is typical of an immersion setting, and while it can be a bit frustrating and even frightening at first, with regular practice, you will be able to understand more of the details and develop your own communicative competence that will aid you in your academic career, internships, and possibly even employment.

### Formal Requirements:

You must have the text and workbook with CDs by the end of the first week of class. The dictionary and Cruise should be brought each day to class.

## SUBMITTING HOMEWORK

### **Procedure/Attendance:**

Considering that most of the learning in a language class takes place in the classroom, punctual attendance at all scheduled classes and related events is required. Russian is the official language of the classroom, so please attempt to phrase questions and remarks in Russian, using English as a last resort – we will help you. You may bring a drink to class, but food and gum are strictly forbidden (standing in line to purchase items is not an excuse for lateness). Cell phones must be turned OFF (not vibrate or silent) during class.

- ❖ Late arrival: 15-20 min = ½ absence
- ❖ More than 20 min = 1 absence
- ❖ Three unexcused absences are allowed per semester.
- ❖ Each additional unexcused absence will lower your final grade by two points.
- ❖ Excused absences that are anticipated (athletic/religious event) must be communicated to the instructor in writing at the beginning of the semester.
- ❖ All assignments that have been excused fall under the excused policy for grading, but should be submitted in advance if possible.
- ❖ Tests/quests/quizzes missed due to an excused absence are your responsibility and must be made up within a week.
- ❖ Unexcused absence tests/quests/quizzes/homework earn a zero and cannot be made up.

**Online Translator Warning:**

Assignments should be completed in Russian. Do not write in English and then translate. The use of online or electronic translators is not only counter-productive and deceptive, but is prohibited and considered a form of plagiarism which will be reported to the Honor Board.

**Student Assignments:**

Learning a foreign language requires daily practice. You should be prepared to spend 1 ½ -2 hours outside of class for every hour in class. This four-hour class represents a total commitment of 12 hours per week.

Compositions-Note the dates of the compositions: these are not negotiable and represent 10% of your grade. When you write a composition, you have time to verify grammar. You are allowed to rewrite the first draft of a composition for a higher grade, but the two grades will be averaged. All drafts must be typed, double-spaced on 8 ½ x 11" printer paper. Handwritten compositions will not be accepted.

Oral Presentations-For each test, you will need to present a dialogue that you have constructed with a partner. For the midterm and final, a group sketch will be presented. For all orals, a written script must be handed in as well. If your partner does not appear on test day, you must be able to complete your lines as I read your partner's. No make-ups or late orals will be accepted.

Language Lab- Language lab assignments are made at the beginning of every two sections and are due by the quest/test. You may either go to Hopkins lab (free) or pay \$7 to get a password to stream in the audio. These are counted as homework assignments.

Missing Class-Make-up exams will be allowed only in extraordinary circumstances (death in the family, serious illness). You will be provided with a roster (phone and e mails as each student permits). If you are absent, I suggest that you contact a reliable student for details about the class, as the plan for the day might have changed based on student needs. You may certainly contact me for clarification, but depending on the time that you initiate contact, I may not be able to respond before the next class in time for the required assignments to be completed. You are responsible for all assignments that were due that day, as well as for the following day (including homework, quizzes, and tests), so it is important to find out what you missed in class.

Additional Help: If you find you need additional help completing the assigned work for this course, do take advantage of my office hours or make an appointment at a mutually-convenient time.
